

Newton International Fellowships

This scheme provides support for outstanding international early career researchers in the natural sciences to make a first step towards developing an independent research career.

The fellowship enables researchers to establish and conduct their research in a UK host organisation, access expertise, and build long-lasting collaborative relationships.

The two-year fellowship provides up to £280,000 of funding, which can cover salary, research expenses and associated overheads, plus relocation and visa costs for the Newton International Fellow and their dependants (partner and children).

The fellowship also offers training, networking and career development, and the opportunity to join the Newton International Fellowship Alumni programme with access to follow-on funding to support continued networking activities with UK-based researchers.

The Newton International Fellowship is a flexible award, which can be held on a part-time basis for health reasons and caring responsibilities.

Financial support is available for childcare costs that arise from attending conferences and research visits.

There is also provision for extended sick leave, and maternity, paternity, adoptive and shared parental leave.
